



EU Export to Third Countries

The export of a plant, vegetable, or object to third countries requires a phytosanitary certificate issued by the competent authority by the International Convention for the Protection of Plants (IPPC) and relevant international standards. The IPPC is an intergovernmental treaty signed by over 180 Countries aiming to protecting the word's plant resources from the spread and introduction of pests and promoting s.afe trade.

Pre-Export

The authorities of the State from which plants, vegetables, or other objects are exported exchange the necessary phytosanitary information to issue the pre-export phytosanitary certificate.

The pre-export certificate is issued upon request of the professional operator, who accompanies the plants, vegetables, or objects during their movement within the EU territory and certifies their conformity.

Electronic Notification System

The Commission establishes an electronic system for the transmission of notifications by Member States and is connected and compatible with a management information system for EU official controls.









The regulation 2022/2389 allows to reduce the rate of **physical checks** on certain goods from specific low-risk phytosanitary origin countries. The European Commission annually publishes updated minimum check rates

Importation of fruit products


Number of controlled shipments in Liguria 2020

How do the checks take place?

FOR PHYSICAL CHECKS (SANITARY, VETERINARY, PHYTOPATHOLOGY AND AGECONTROL), it always depends on the type of productand the percentage of verification notified by the EU based on alerts, a minimum of 48 H before the ship arrival, for each entity, the required documentation is entered on various portals.




THE PHYTOPATHOLOGIST REQUIRES DIGITAL OR ORIGINAL PAPER CERTIFICATES, for practice, a week before the product arrival, copies are required: insurance policy, phytosanitary certificate, origin or EUR certificate, invoice, packing list and/or other documentation depending on the type of goods.

Terminal movement costs



- TERMINAL MOVEMENT COSTS: as per current rates; an average of Eur 175.00/cntr to Eur 220/cntr; it depends on if the goods need to be emptied in warehouses for in-depth checks required by the phytopathologist.
- SANITARY: Eur 15.08 in normal cases; Eur 55.28 for increased checks.
- PHYTOSANITARY: Eur 31.50 up to a maximum of 25,000 net weight.
- RELEASE TIMELINES, Sanitary clearance, phytosanitary certificate and conformity certificate issued by AGECONTROL: in the afternoon
- CONNECTION TO COLUMNS: depends on the shipping companies (e.g. MSC no free time Eur 57.00/cntr/day Hapag Lloyd 2-day Free time Eur 60.00/cntr/day + Eur 155.00/cntr/day for Port Storage)
- THE DATA TO CONSIDER ARE:
 - · the maximum and minimum range
 - · the costs of health and phytosanitary certifications
 - · the costs of stopping at columns and terminal franchise times
